## The Great Eastern Tracker - Saturday 23rd May 2015

In partnership with Abellio Greater Anglia (AGA) and using Mk1/Mk2 coaching stock with top n' tail Class 47s from West Coast Railway Company, this exciting and highly unusual fund raising railtour includes the sought after **Norwich Crown Point Depot** and **Ilford Depot** as its main highlights. In addition it provides a wide variety of unusual loops, sidings and routing including the **Wensum Curve** and the **Bacon Factory Curve**. The train is uniquely scheduled to be piloted by Norwich Crown Point Class 08 shunting locomotive **08754**. A leg stretch and photographic break has been scheduled for Liverpool Street.

All profits from the charter will be donated to AGA's nominated charity, **The Railway Children.** As usual, our fund raising activity will be supported by an on train raffle, sale of snacks and light refreshments and the opportunity to purchase souvenirs of the day. Participants will receive a souvenir ticket, comprehensive tour brochure including a detailed route description, track map and timing sheet to aid their enjoyment.

Norwich P3 (PU 07:00) – Trowse D&U Loop (REV) – Wensum Curve – Carriage Wash / Bypass Line (Attach 08754 to rear, REV) – Reception Sidings N°. 1 – Norwich Station Middle Siding (Detach 08, REV) – Trowse Jn Down Main – Lakenham Crossover to Up Main – Diss (PU 09:00) - Diss UTS – Stowmarket P2 (PU 09:17) - Stowmarket U&DGL – Ipswich Yard Up Goods – Ipswich – Colchester Up Goods – Marks Tey UPL – Witham UPL – Chelmsford Dn Loop - Shenfield UPL – Up Main – Gidea Park Up Electric - Romford Up Main – Ilford Depot Country End Jn – Ilford Carriage Road N°.1 – Crossovers to Up Main – Ilford Up Pass Avoiding Line – Up Electric – Bethnal Green West Jn, crossovers to Up Suburban – Liverpool Street P3 or P4 (leg stretch, REV) – Down Suburban – Cambridge Heath – Graham Road Curve – Canonbury Jn – Finsbury Park Branch (REV) – Lea Jn – Temple Mills – Orient Way Carriage Sidings (REV) – High Meads Jn – Channelsea Jns – Stratford – Down Main – Ilford Down Pass Avoiding – Ilford Carriage Road N°.2 – Down Electric – Crossover to Down Main at Gidea Park Country End – Shenfield – Ingatestone - Chelmsford - Witham DPL (enter after station) – Colchester Carriage Sidings Reception Road – Colchester – Manningtree – Mistley DGL – Wrabness Emergency Crossovers (REV) – Manningtree North Curve – Ipswich P4 – Felixstowe Town (REV) – Boss Hall Jn – Bacon Factory Curve – Europa Jn – Claydon DGL – Stowmarket (SD 17:09) – Diss P2 (SD 17:24) - Norwich P2 (SD 17:50).
